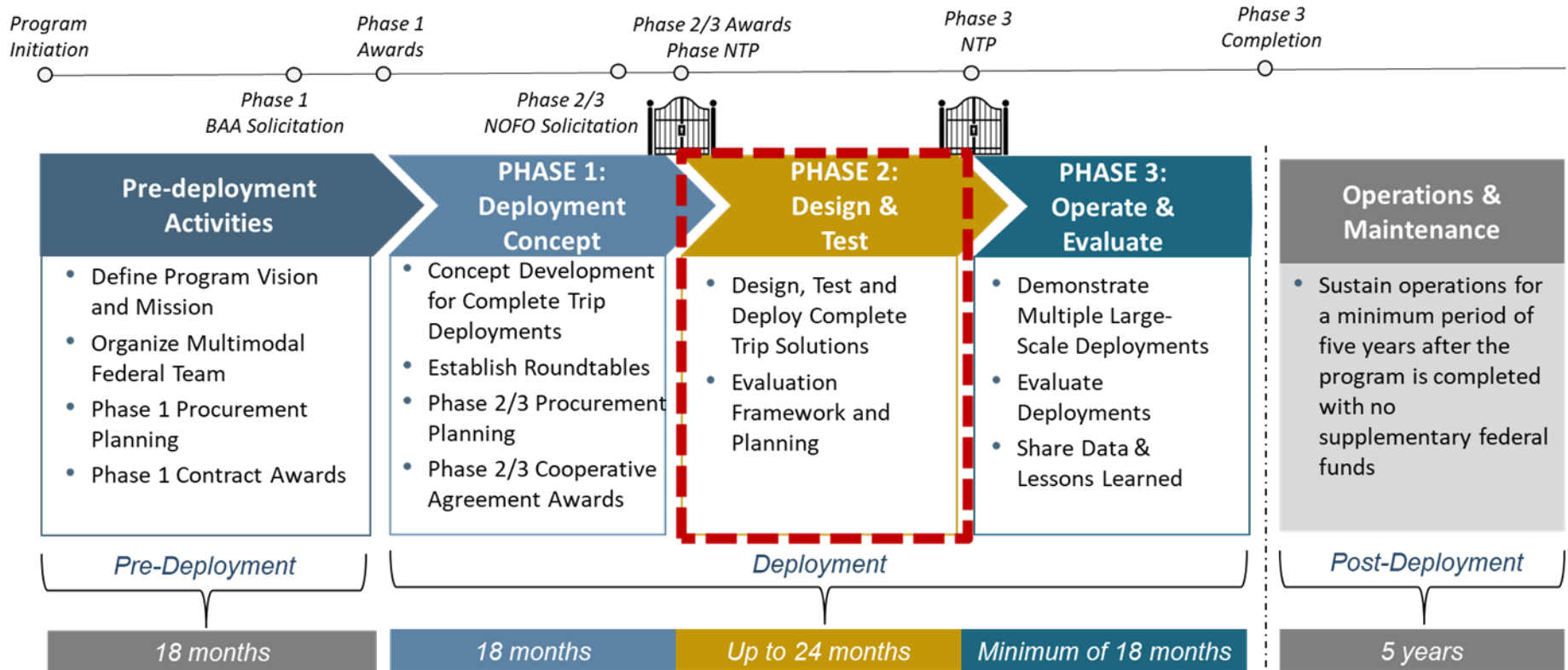
ITS4US Program Overview

- Supports multiple large-scale replicable deployments to address the challenges of planning and executing all segments of a complete trip

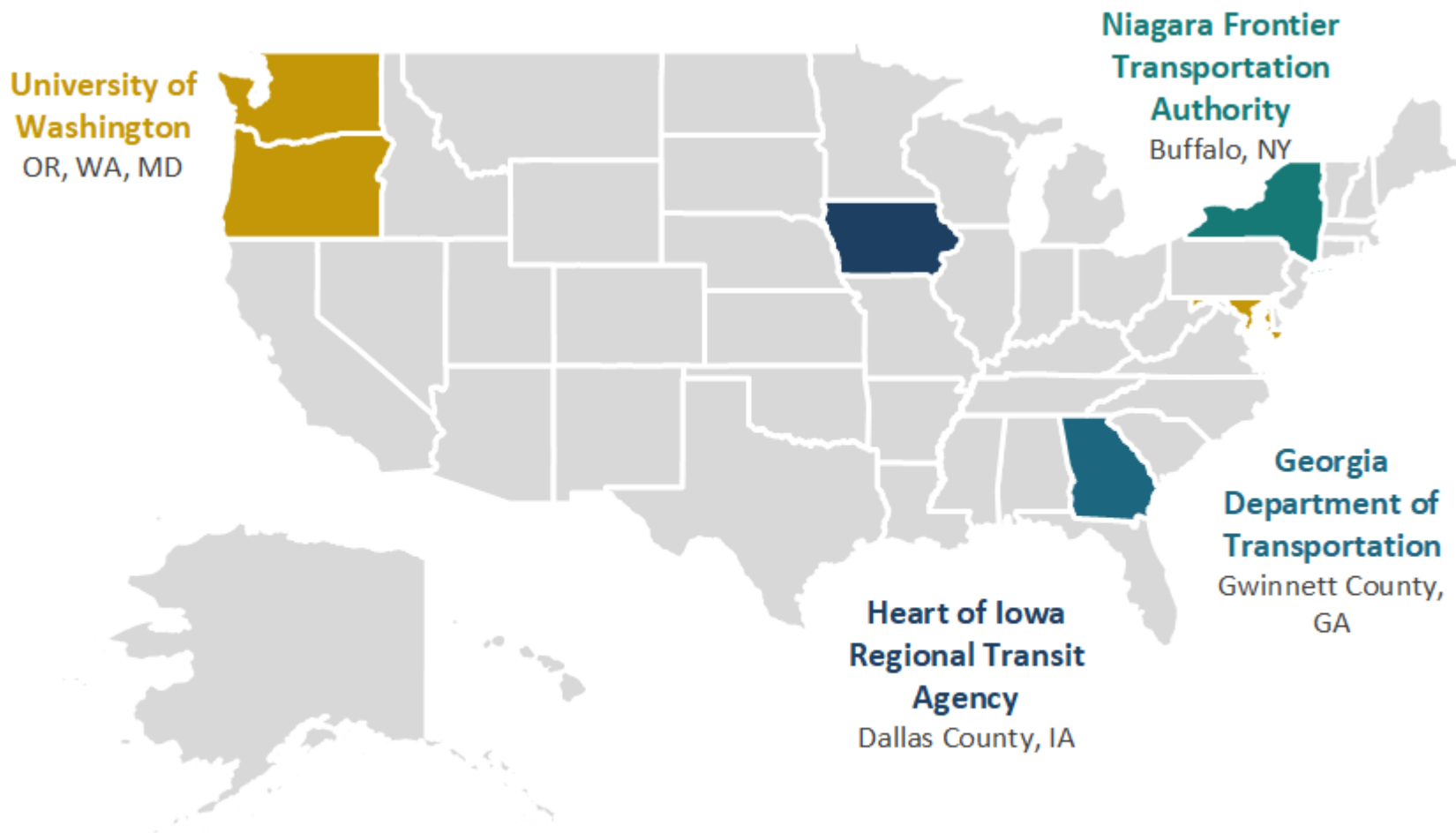


Vision: Innovative and integrated complete trip deployments to support seamless travel for all users across all modes, regardless of location, income, or disability

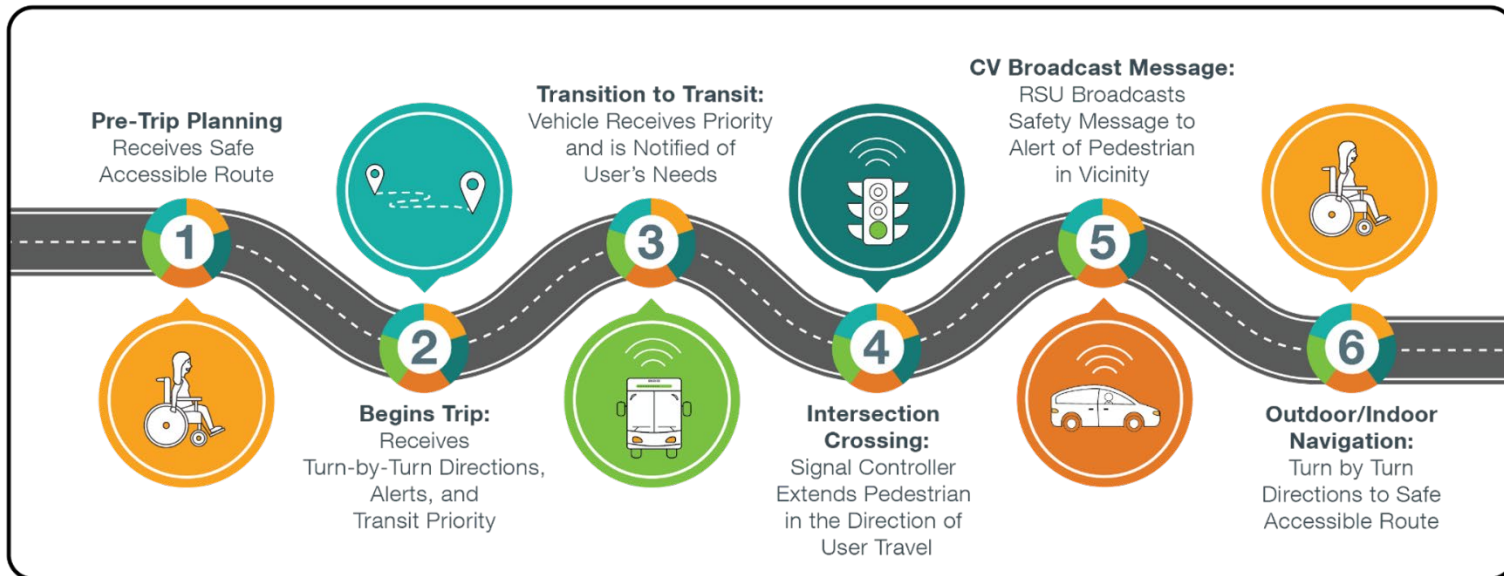
Deployment Phases



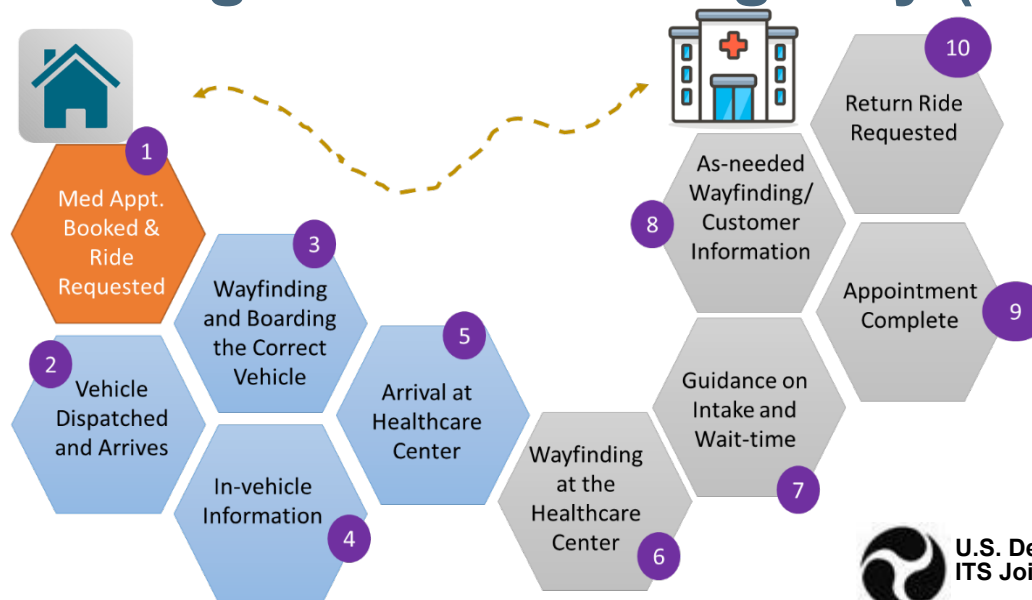
ITS4US Deployment Sites



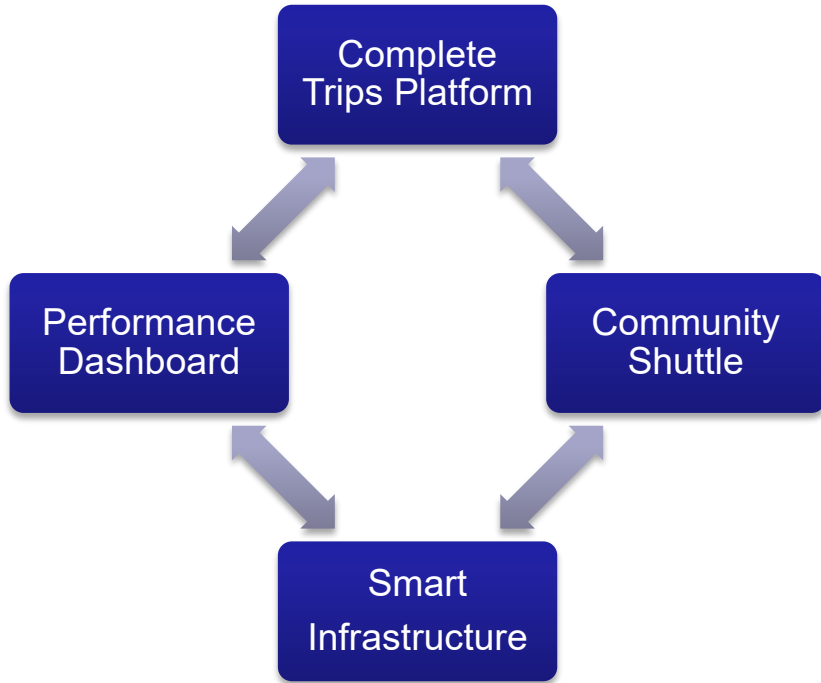

Heart of Iowa Regional Transit Agency (HIRTA)

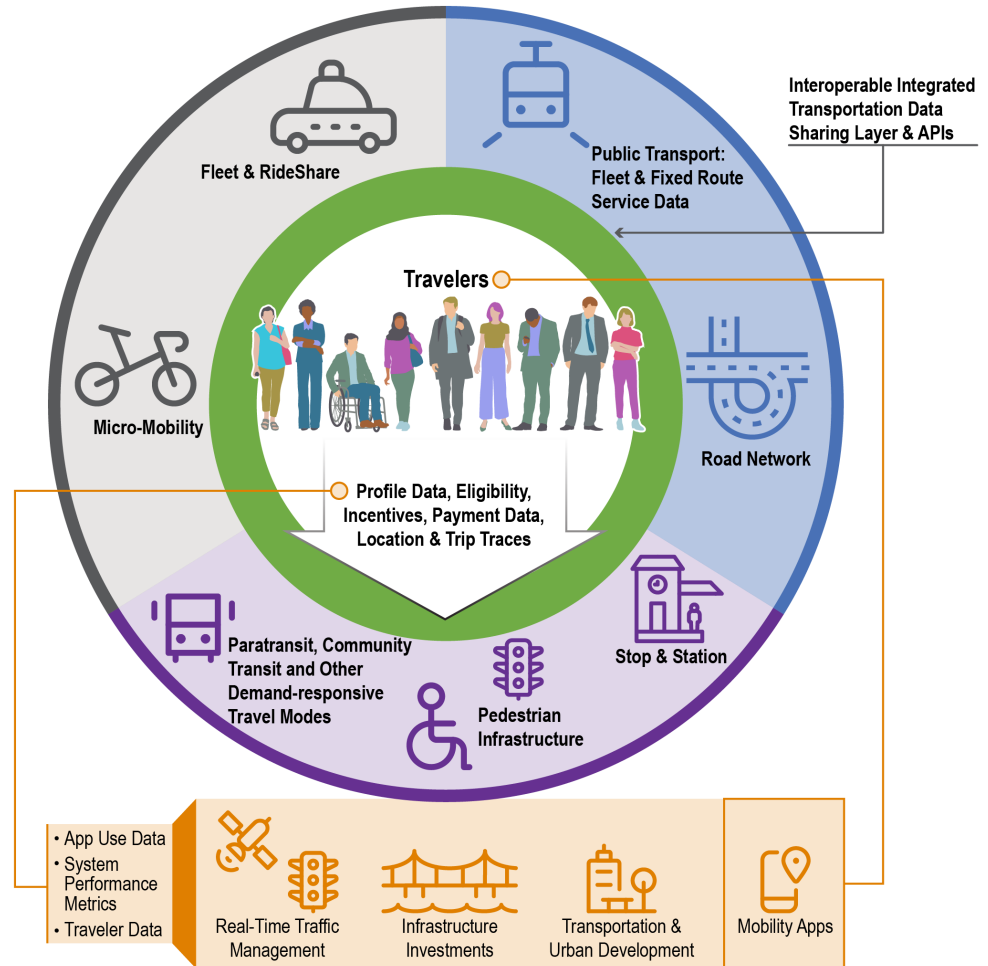

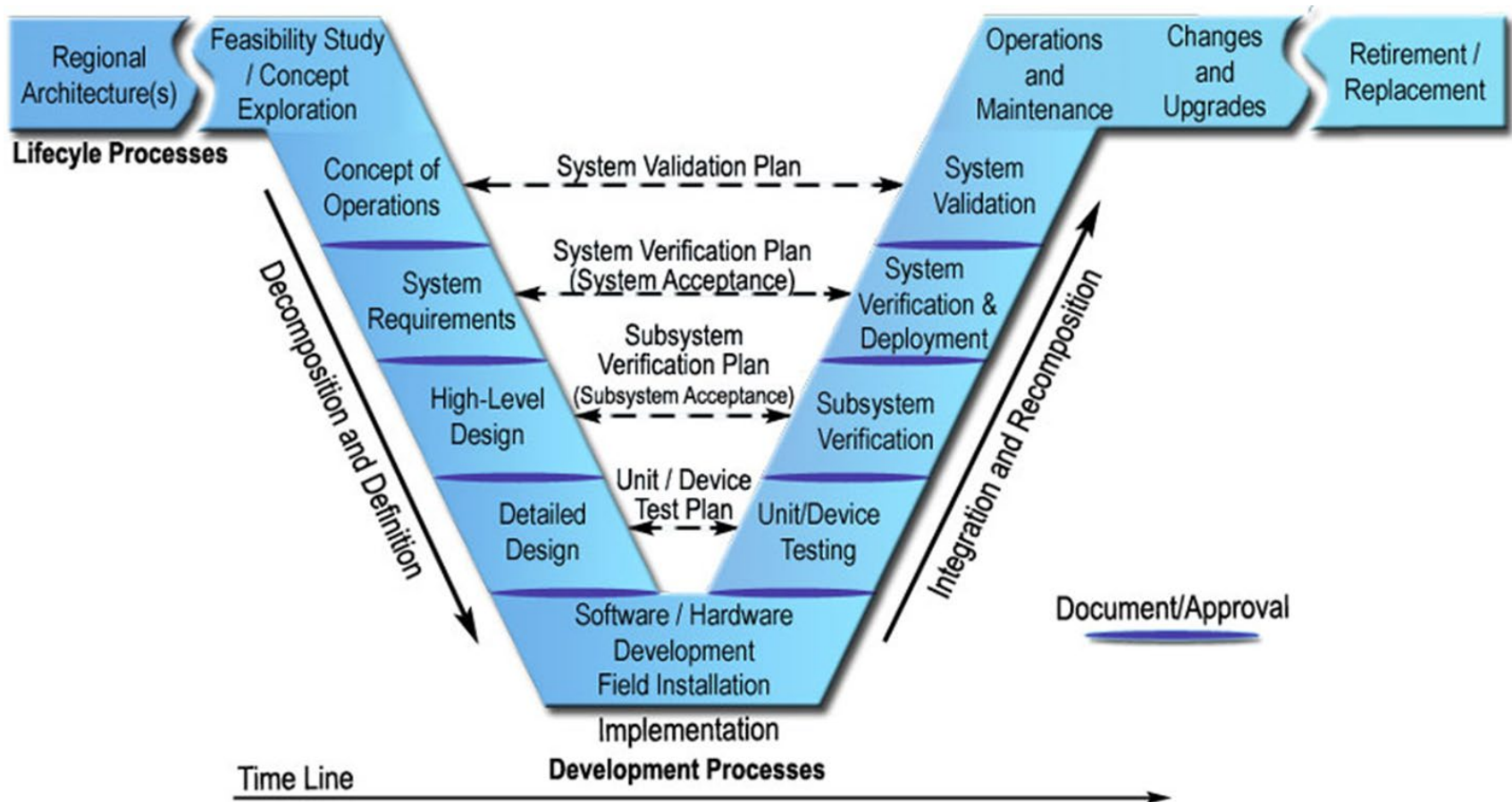

Resources to Support Equity

Subject Matter Expertise

- Guide sites for successful deployments
- Provide subject matter review of site plans and technical documentation
- Review materials for accessibility and equity
- Develop technical trainings and templates to assist sites and future deployers

Technology Transfer

- Publish all deployment documentation and training materials
- Promote site successes and lessons learned through public webinar and industry conferences
- Provide materials in accessible formats (e.g., 508 compliance, closed captioning, ASL interpretation, providing recordings with transcripts)

- The ITS4Equity Deployment Program aims to **reduce inequities** through **ITS solutions** to promote **safe, affordable, and accessible** multimodal access to opportunities and services to communities.
